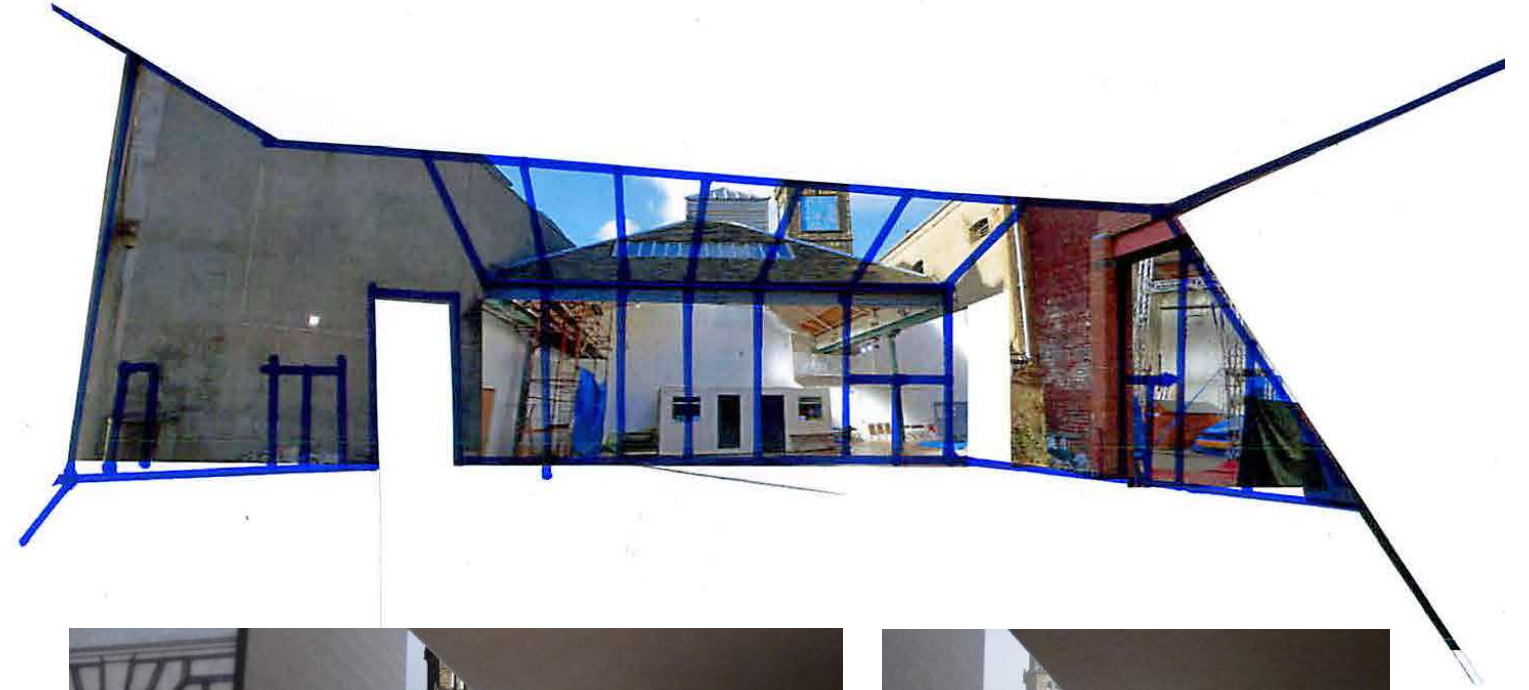

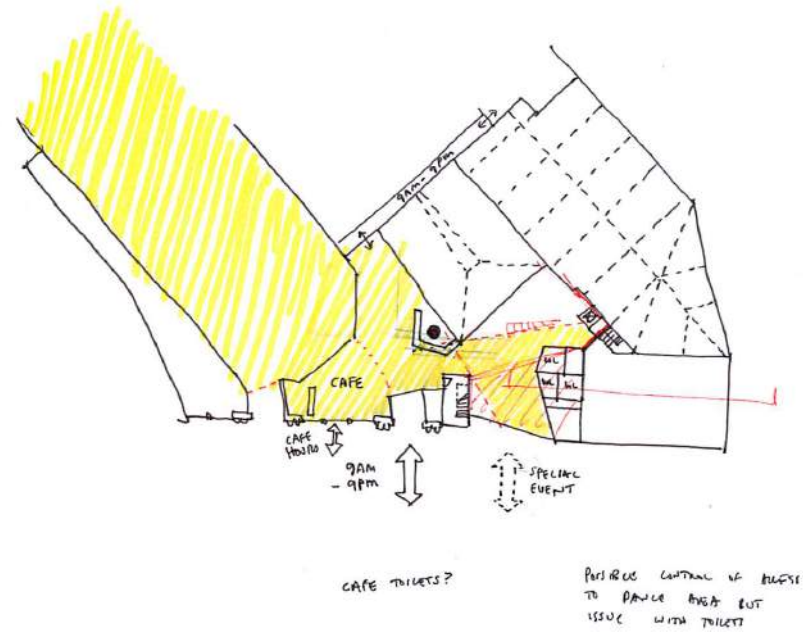

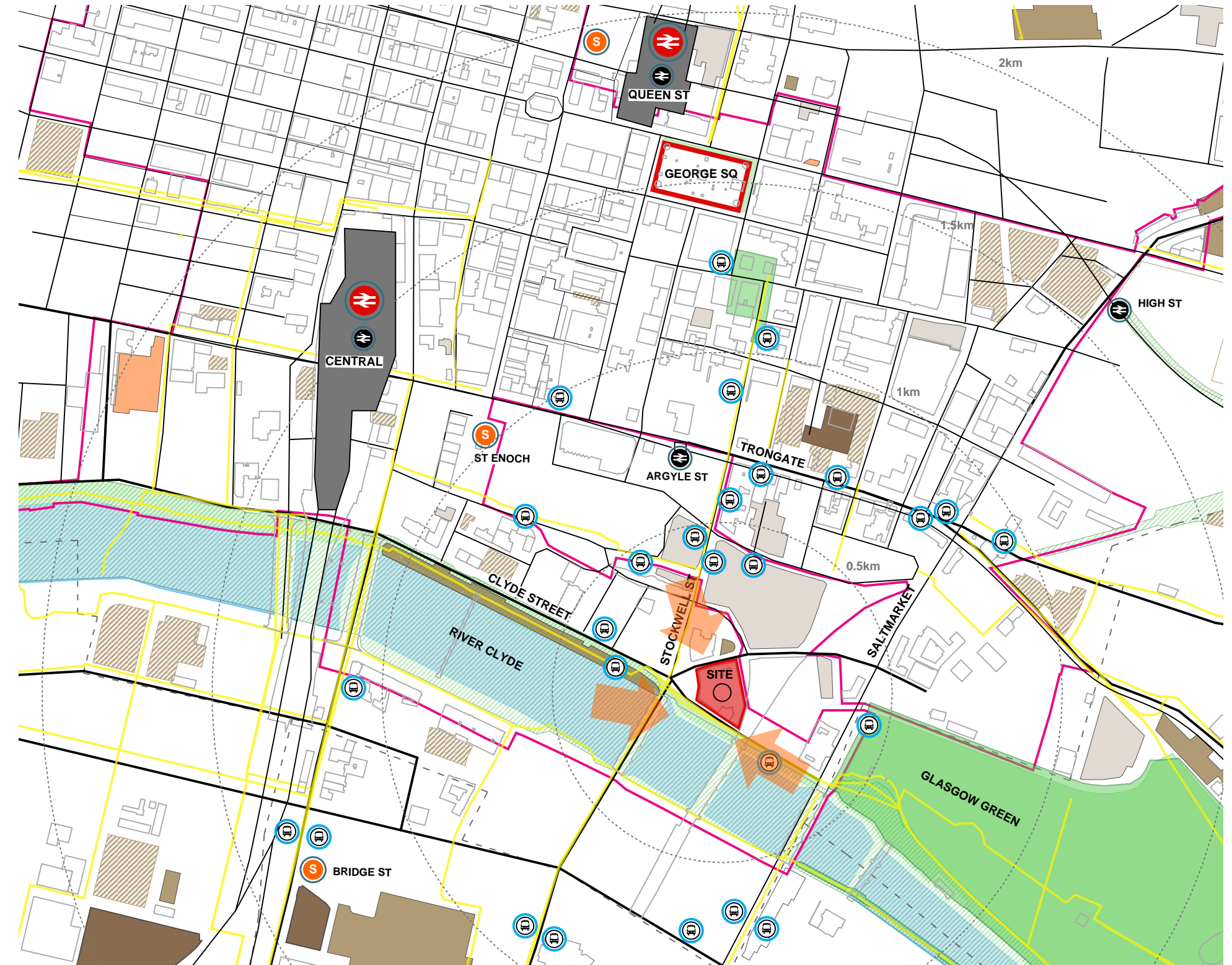

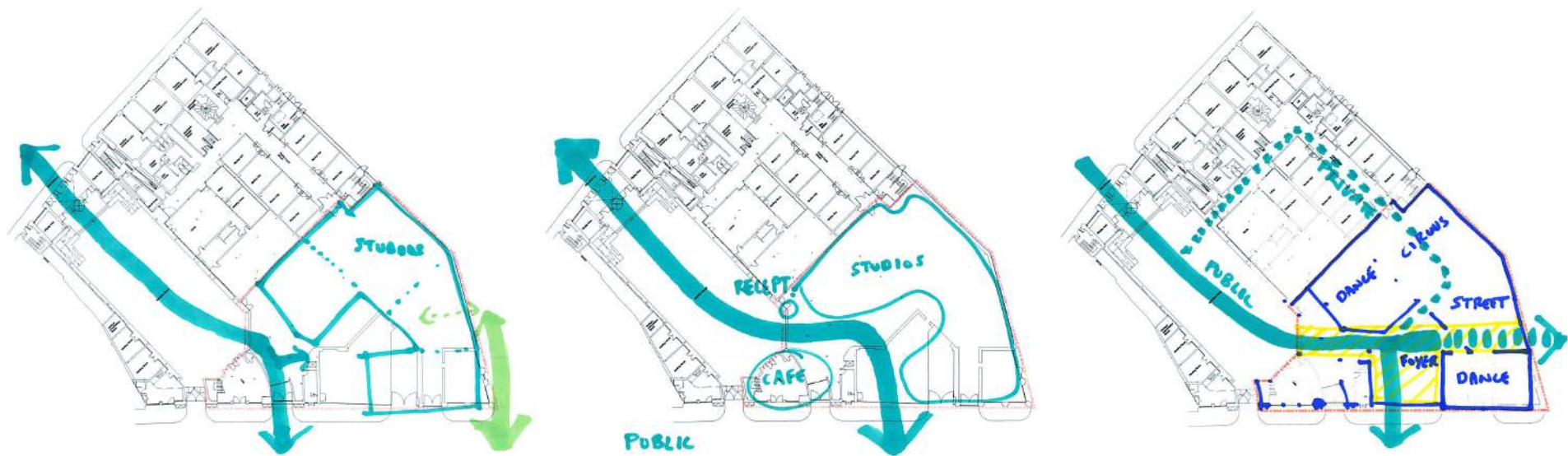


Concept Diagram inside existing structure | study models

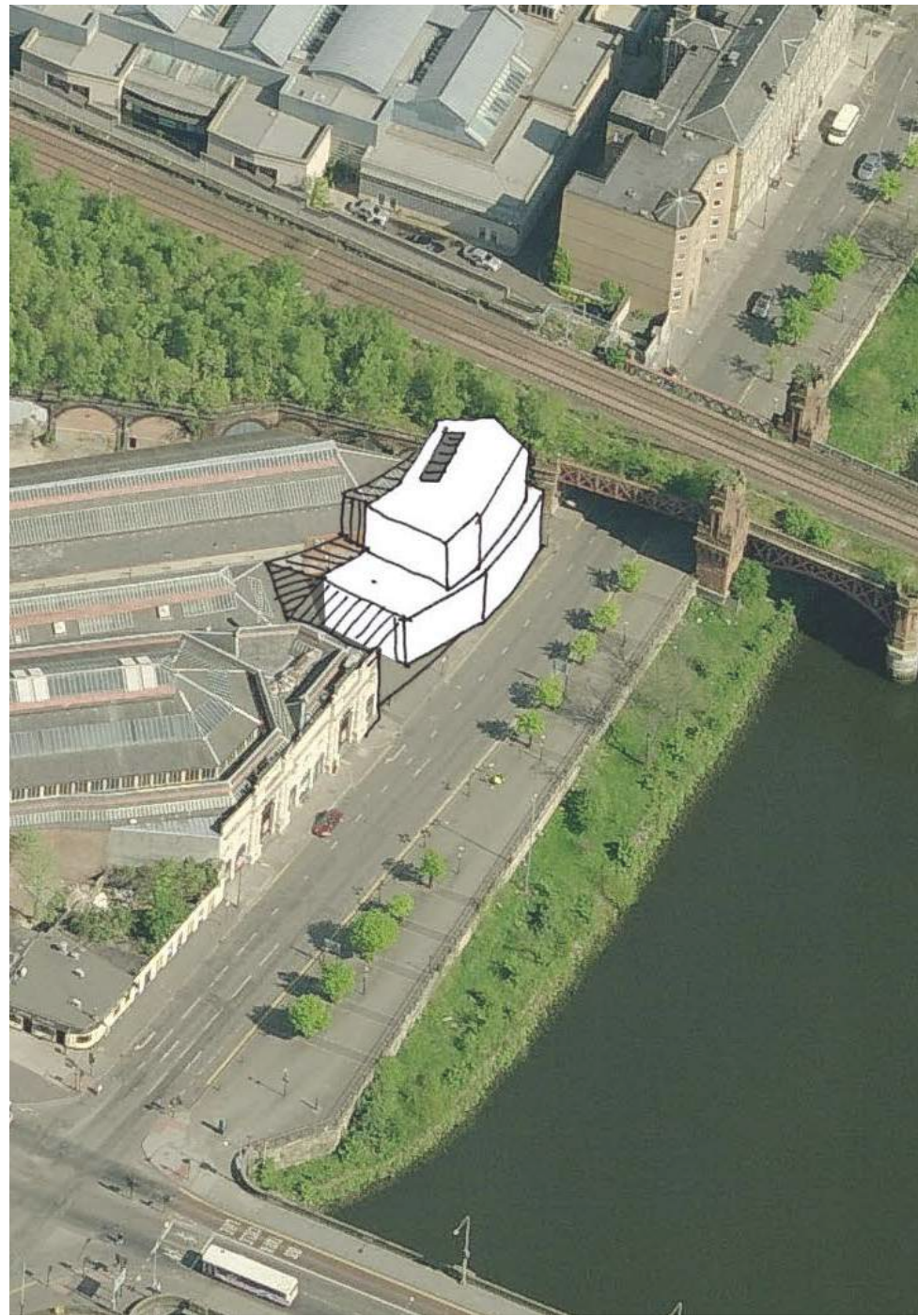
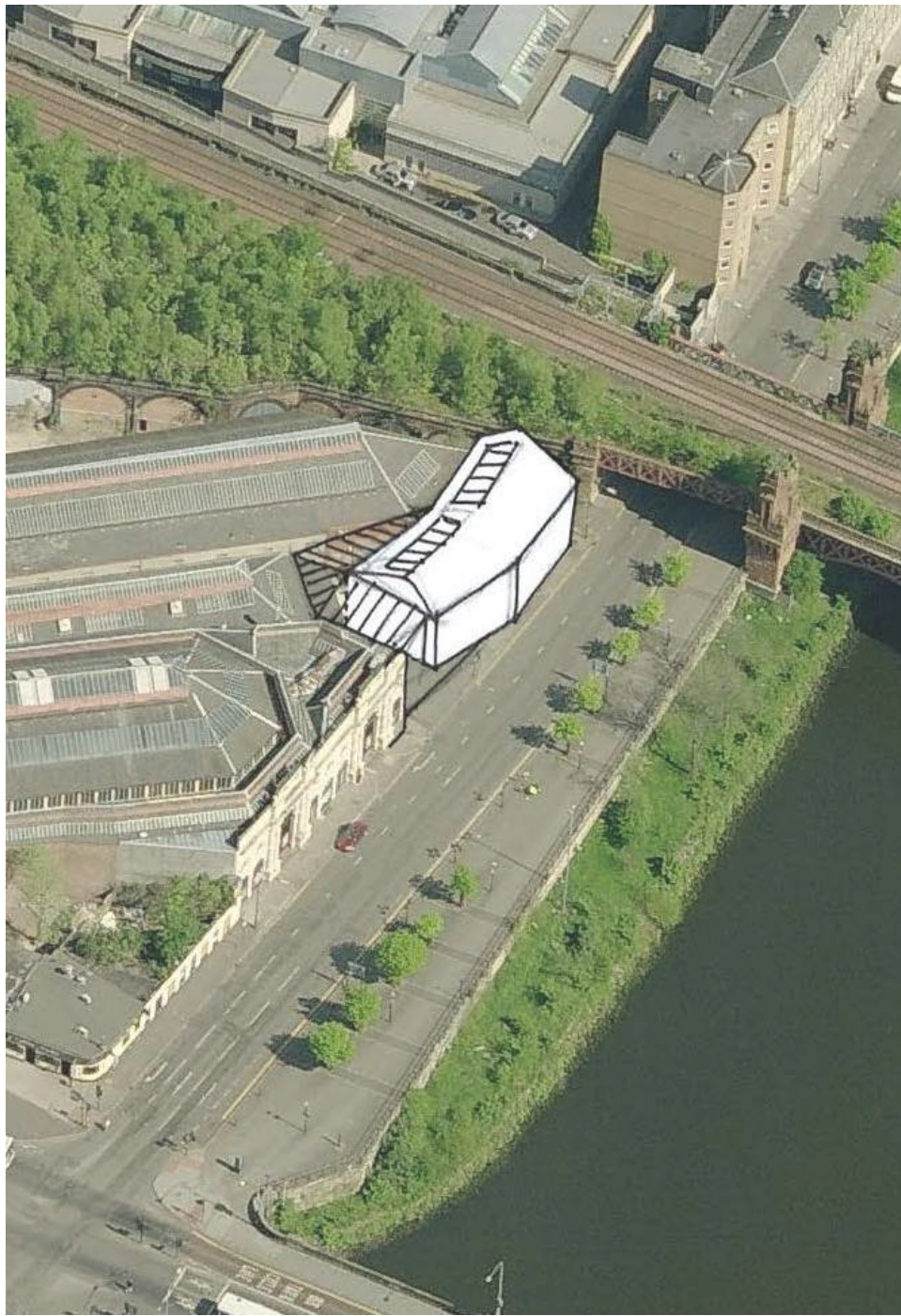

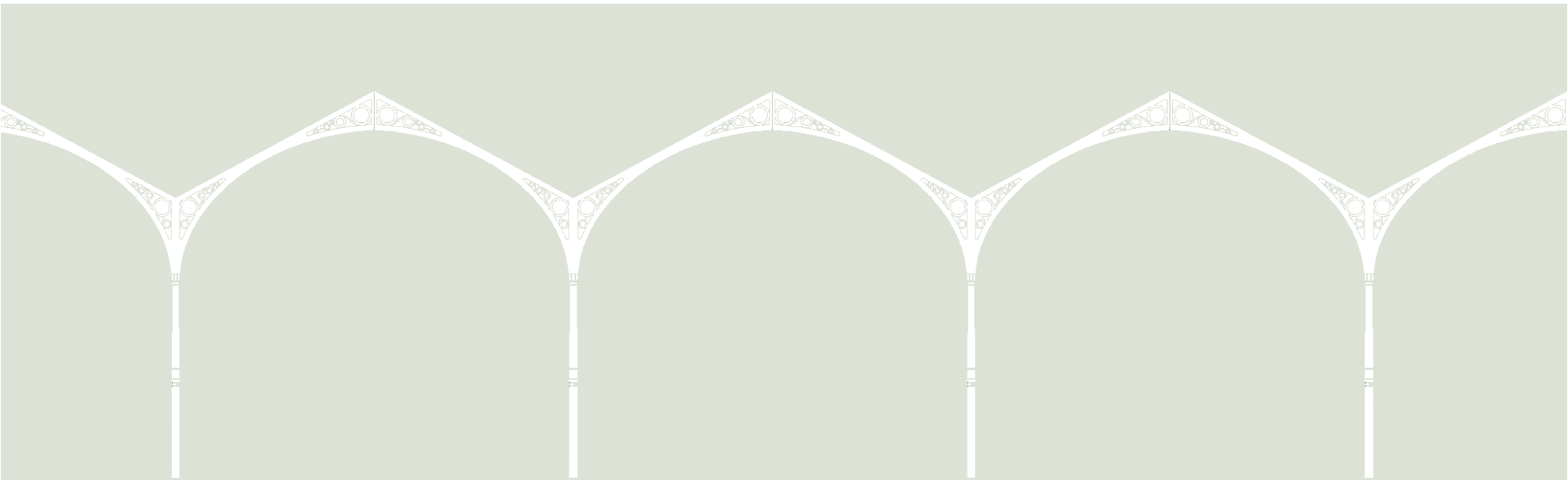
